Yachad/Together

Many of us are familiar with the Hebrew root *yod-chet-daled*, *yachad* made famous in the song, “Hinei Matov umanim shevet achim gam Yachad how good it is to dwell together.”

The first time we see this root is early in the Torah. Abram and Sarah travelled to Israel with a large entourage, including Abram’s nephew Lot. This caravan eventually reached its destination. The Torah tells us (Genesis 13:6): “The land was not able to bear them that they might live together (*yachdav*) for their possessions were great, so that they could not live together (*yachdav*).”

We understand the challenge of the land supporting a large population. But *yachad* is repeated twice in the verse to suggest that the issues goes beyond physical sustainability. The land didn’t support them because they were not a community. They did not work together. They did not want to live together. They could not co-exist.

What happened? Abram and Lot divide their property and went their separate ways. The story of Sodom and Gomorrah follows immediately to teach that the lack of coexistence led to the downfall of society.

Our community – and really the entire world – has been apart for some time. Over the past year, we experienced what it meant to be alone. We felt what it was to be isolated. Like Abraham and Lot, we experienced disagreement and discord that lead to an unsafe world.

But as a people and as a country, we cannot afford to do what Abraham and Lot did. We can’t allow ourselves to divide and go our separate ways. Our planet won’t sustain it. Our society won’t survive it. Now more than ever, we must reaffirm our commitment to one another, to establishing a sacred community that dwells together in harmony, wisdom and joy. We must support each other, care for each other, value each other. This is what we mean when we say, “Beth El B’yachad Beth El Together.”

Today, the notion of “together” is expanding. We come together for socializing, services and for study both in person and virtually. To be sure, there are differences in the experience. Zoom is good for some things, less good for other things. But whatever the platform, whatever the protocols, when we reaffirm our covenant with God who is Echad, One, we can overcome that which separates us and divides us. When see each other as achim, as family, when we recognize God’s oneness, we sense that which connects and unites all.

As you can imagine, the shooting created fear for those in attendance and several fans ended up in Nationals’ clubhouse near manager, Dave Martinez’s office. As security came by to check on those in the clubhouse, they asked if those in the area were family. To which, Martinez replied, “Yes, they are family – they’re our fans.”

This horrible and chaotic story struck me immediately. As our Beth El Community, you are our family. You’re more than fans of course and I don’t mean to limit you to such. It’s for this reason that when it comes to your safety – COVID, threats, or otherwise – and, finding ways to bring us together – that it is so important. Because, when you’re family, you want to be together – B’yachad.

This new model more clearly defines Beth El's administrative functions, identifies areas for resource improvement, and enables our clergy to better focus on the pastoral and community work for which they are uniquely qualified.

I believe that the work we have done and will continue to do will light our way as we align with our mission and vision. We are a strong and vibrant community actively learning as a community, connecting as a community, and serving as a community.

I am continually impressed by the mutual love and commitment we all have for the future of Beth El Synagogue and optimistic as always that we will successfully go forward, together as a community, with our young and our old.

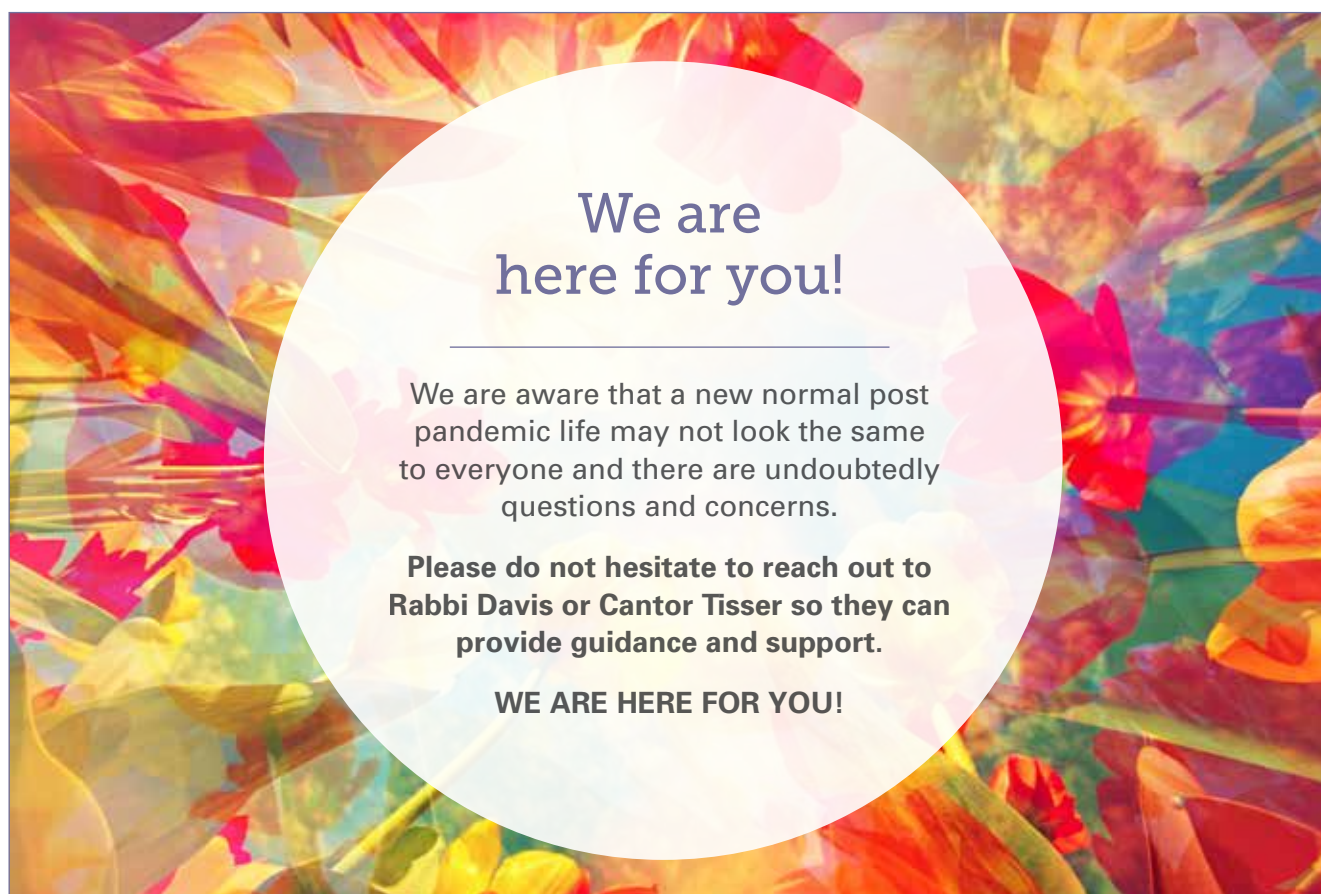
