Peshustim Mehudarim Tefillin, Kosher Tefillin. Our Parshiyot are not on Meshuach (painted klaf) and are inspected to insure the Kashrut. These are not high level Tefillin.

Quality Kosher Tefillin we do not use Meshuach (white painted parchment) in any of our Tefillin. The housings are 2" square around the base and 1 1/2 inch square around the housings of the parchments. All our Tefillin come with Plastic cases that protect the Tefillin from all sides when not in use.

Beth El uses a minhag (tradition) of teaching b'nai mitzvah students how to wrap the Ashkenazi version of tefillin so you should select "**Ashkenazi**" under **Minhag**. Then choose whether your child is **right or left-handed**.
