
# **ARTIST IN RESIDENCE**



Rabbi Matthew L. Berkowitz is the Director of Israel Programs for The Jewish Theological Seminary of America and co-founder of *Kol Ha-Ot*, a Jerusalem-based venture devoted to exploring the arts and Jewish learning. An accomplished artist, Matt was formally trained in Jewish scribal art in Jerusalem and completed the writing of *Megillat Esther*, the illumination of several *ketubbot*, and a limited edition artist portfolio entitled *Passover Landscapes: Illuminations on the Exodus*. His work includes: *The Lovell Haggadah*, a series of notable *tzedakah* boxes, and other major commissions.
